The Creation Story (Genesis 1-2) was written by Moses as attested by the rest of the Bible. The English word "genesis" comes from a Greek word that means "origin."

<u> Theological Takeaways || Genesis 1:1-2</u>

- God spoke the universe into existence out of nothing and created order.
- God demonstrates that He is sovereign Creator, authoritative Lord and loving Father.
- God's hand never leaves His creation.
- God's "good" creation is a reflection of His character. He sets the standards.

Day 3: Earth and plants (Genesis 1:9-13)

Day 4: Sun, moon and stars (Genesis 1:14-19)

Day 5: Fish and birds (Genesis 1:20-23)

Day 6: Animals and mankind (Genesis 1:24-31)

- Detailed story of man and woman's creation in Genesis 2:4-25
- God is at the center of the universe, but mankind is at the center of God's heart.
- God created the world for His children, who were made in His image.
- Mankind's purpose was to have dominion and expand His order worldwide.
