



Camp Rules

- 1. Be present and on time to every event including meals, teaching sessions and activities.**
- 2. No camper (student or adult leader) is allowed to be in the sleeping quarters of the opposite sex.**
- 3. Cell phones, iPods, MP3 players, video games and other electronic devices are not to be used during worship services, break-out sessions or church times.**
- 4. Alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, firearms, fireworks and knives are strictly prohibited.**
- 5. The camp property is your home for the week. Please help us keep the grounds as clean as possible. Proper respect for the camp facility is expected.**
- 6. Please bring your Bible and something to write with to all worship services and break-out sessions.**
- 7. Students will not be allowed outside of their rooms after curfew.**
- 8. No PDA with the opposite sex and no being off alone with the opposite sex. Married couples are the ONLY exception!**
- 9. Pranks are not allowed, even within your own group.**
- 10. Clothing must be modest and respectful. Girls, no short shorts and no tops that show your midriff or cleavage. Guys, wear a shirt at all times unless you are in the water. Both sexes, no clothing with suggestive or offensive images or phrases. If we see any of these items, you will be asked to change or cover up.**

You alone are responsible for your actions at camp. We want this week to be a time for you to focus on your relationship with Christ and grow deeper in your knowledge and love for Him. Hook-ups, pranks, revealing clothing and other distractions hinder spiritual growth not only for you but also for those around you.
