Theological Takeaways:

Sin is when we make ourselves the center of the story.

Sin affects everything and creates shame, fear, separation and a fallen world.

Everything is broken when our relationship with God is not right. We must look only to Him to redeem the brokenness.

God begins to show glimpses of redemption:

- The Seed of the woman will crush the serpent's head. (Genesis 3:15)
- The blood sacrifice is accepted. (Genesis 3:21)
- The righteous are saved on the ark. (Genesis 6-9)
