The Twelve Tribes of Israel:

- Reuben
- Simeon
- Levi (Tribe of Priests || Aaron's lineage become the High Priests)
- Judah (The line of blessing passes through Judah to David)
- Issachar
- Zebulun
- Joseph (Ephraim and Manasseh are his two sons who become tribes)
- Benjamin
- Dan
- Naphtali
- Gad
- Asher

Hebrew names for God in the Old Testament:

- *Elohim* or *El* (earliest, most genetic name, "God," used 2500 times)
- *Adonai* or *Adon* (meaning "Master" translated "Lord," used 450 times)
- *Yahweh* (most personal, meaning "I Am," used 6800 times, written in all caps in English, "LORD")
- *Jehovah* (invented by scribes using the consonants of Yahweh and vowels of Adonai)

Theological Takeaways:

- God redeems from oppression and bondage.
- God has a plan for the future.
- What God is doing today is in line with what He has done in the past.
- God started today's deliverance many years ago.
