## **ONE BIG STORY Timeline**

## Jewish Calendar: (based on the yearly sun cycle and monthly moon cycle)

- 1. Nisan = March/April (14<sup>th</sup>: Passover and 15<sup>th</sup>- 21<sup>st</sup>: Feast of Unleavened Bread)
- 2. Iyar = April/May
- 3. Sivan = May/June (7 weeks past Passover is the Feast of Pentecost)
- 4. Tammuz = June/July
- 5. Ab = July/August
- 6. Elul = August/September
- 7. Tishri = September/October ( $1^{st}$   $2^{nd}$ : Feast of Trumpets,  $10^{th}$ : Day of Atonement,  $15^{th}$   $21^{st}$ : Feast of Tabernacles)
- 8. Heshvan = October/November
- 9. Chislev = November/December (25th: Feast of Lights)
- 10. Tebeth = December/January
- 11. Shebat = January/February
- 12. Adar = February/March (14th: Feast of Purim)

### **Ten Plagues from God:**

- 1. Water turned into blood
- 2. Frogs throughout the land
- 3. Lice
- 4. Flies
- 5. Disease on animals
- 6. Boils on humans
- 7. Hail Storm
- 8. Swarm of Locust
- 9. Three days of darkness
- 10. Death of the First Born (Passover)
