Fall of Israel by Assyria	Prophets: Nahum, Zephaniah, Habakkuk, Jeremiah	First Siege	Second Siege	Fall of Judah by Babylon

Seventh Century Prophets:

Nahum (663-612 B.C.) prophecies against Nineveh
Zephaniah (640 – 612 B.C.) prophecies against Judah
Habakkuk (607 B.C.) prophecies against Judah
Jeremiah (627 – 580 B.C.) prophecies against Judah

World Powers:

Syrians (capital Damascus): 930-732 B.C.
Assyrians (capital Nineveh): 732- 612 B.C.
Babylonians (capital Babylon): 612-539 B.C.
Medo-Persians: 539-330 B.C.
Greeks (capital Athens): 330 – 146 B.C.

Persecutions of Jeremiah:

Jeremiah 11:18-23: conspiracy by people of Anathoth
Jeremiah 20:1-10: beaten and imprisoned by priest
Jeremiah 26:7-24: threatened with death by priests and prophets
Jeremiah 37:11-16: beaten and imprisoned by princes
Jeremiah 38:1-13: imprisoned by princes

Theological Takeaways:

You can not live apart from God and live in the blessing of God.
God disciplines His children redemptively.
